- **Periodical Collection**: Located on the Main Level.

Services

Library Instruction*: Class sessions may be scheduled with Instruction and Resource Sharing Librarian for library orientation or for specific sessions in conjunction with class assignments.

Interlibrary Loan*: Patrons in good standing may request books and journal articles not available through WWC from other libraries. We generally do not borrow videos and DVDs from other libraries. Allow at least one week for delivery.

Reference Assistance: Librarian on duty until 9 p.m. Sunday through Thursday and on Fridays and Saturdays while library is open.

Reserves*: Materials placed on Reserve are kept at the Circulation Desk. Instructors set circulation periods for 3-hour, overnight, or 3-day.

Video Services*: Our video and DVD collection serves to support the college curriculum. Generally, we do not collect feature films. See also *Films on Demand*, our streaming video collection.

Policies

Borrowers: * Only faculty, staff, and currently enrolled WWC students are eligible for these services. Staff families also may check out videos; ACA (Appalachian College Association) cooperative borrowers and registered Community Borrowers (\$30.00 annual fee) are eligible for book checkout only.

Fines: We do not charge overdue fines for most materials (with the exception of reserve items, which are \$.25/hr. overdue). If materials become overdue, no new materials may be checked out and no interlibrary loan requests may be initiated until the patron record is clear. Patrons who damage or lose materials will be charged a fee.

Loan Periods: College I.D. is required to check out materials.
Books and CDs—4 weeks for all borrowers except for faculty and staff, who have semester checkouts.
Videos—3 days for WWC students and staff families; 10 days for faculty and staff.
Rotating Video Collection—2 days for students, faculty and staff.

Other Libraries: WWC students, staff and faculty are eligible for cooperative borrowing cards for use at UNCA's Ramsey Library—request these cards at the Reference Desk. Library cards can also be obtained from the local public library system (Asheville Buncombe Library System) by presenting identification at Pack Library or one of the branches.
