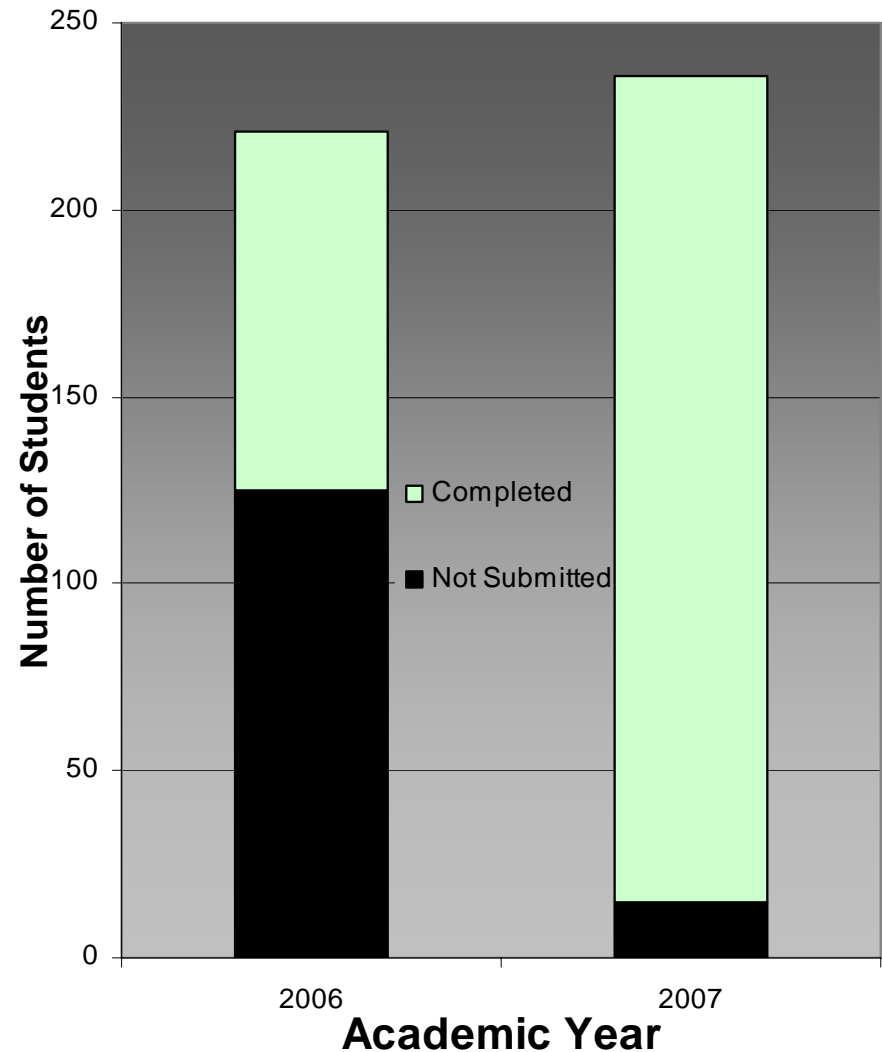

Response Rate – 2007 vs. 2006

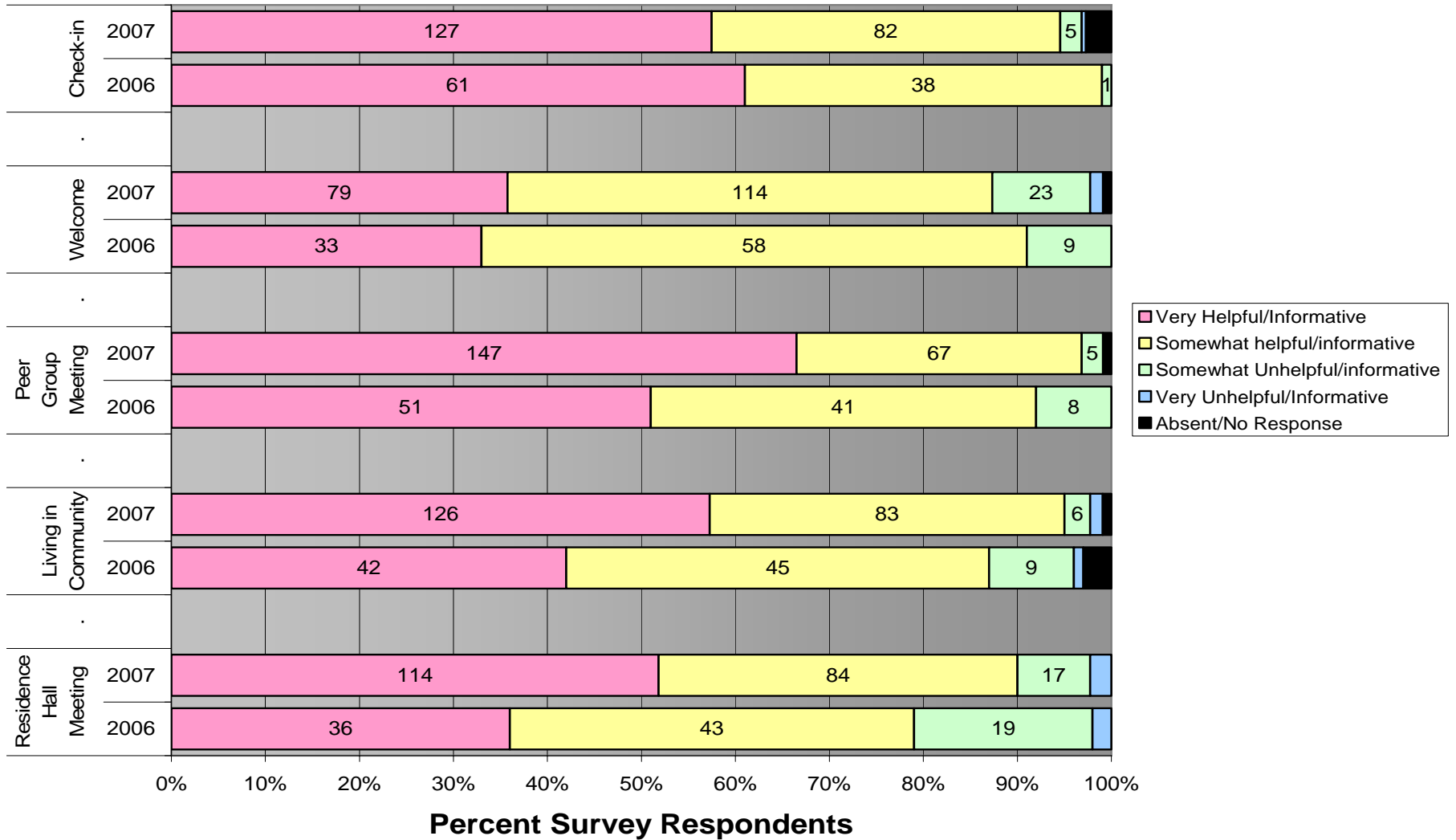
- 2007 – First-year first-time freshmen filled out paper & pencil evaluation forms during a required peer group session
 - Response rate = 93%
- 2006 – New students evaluated Orientation Week through a *Zoomerang*TM survey
 - Response rate = 43%



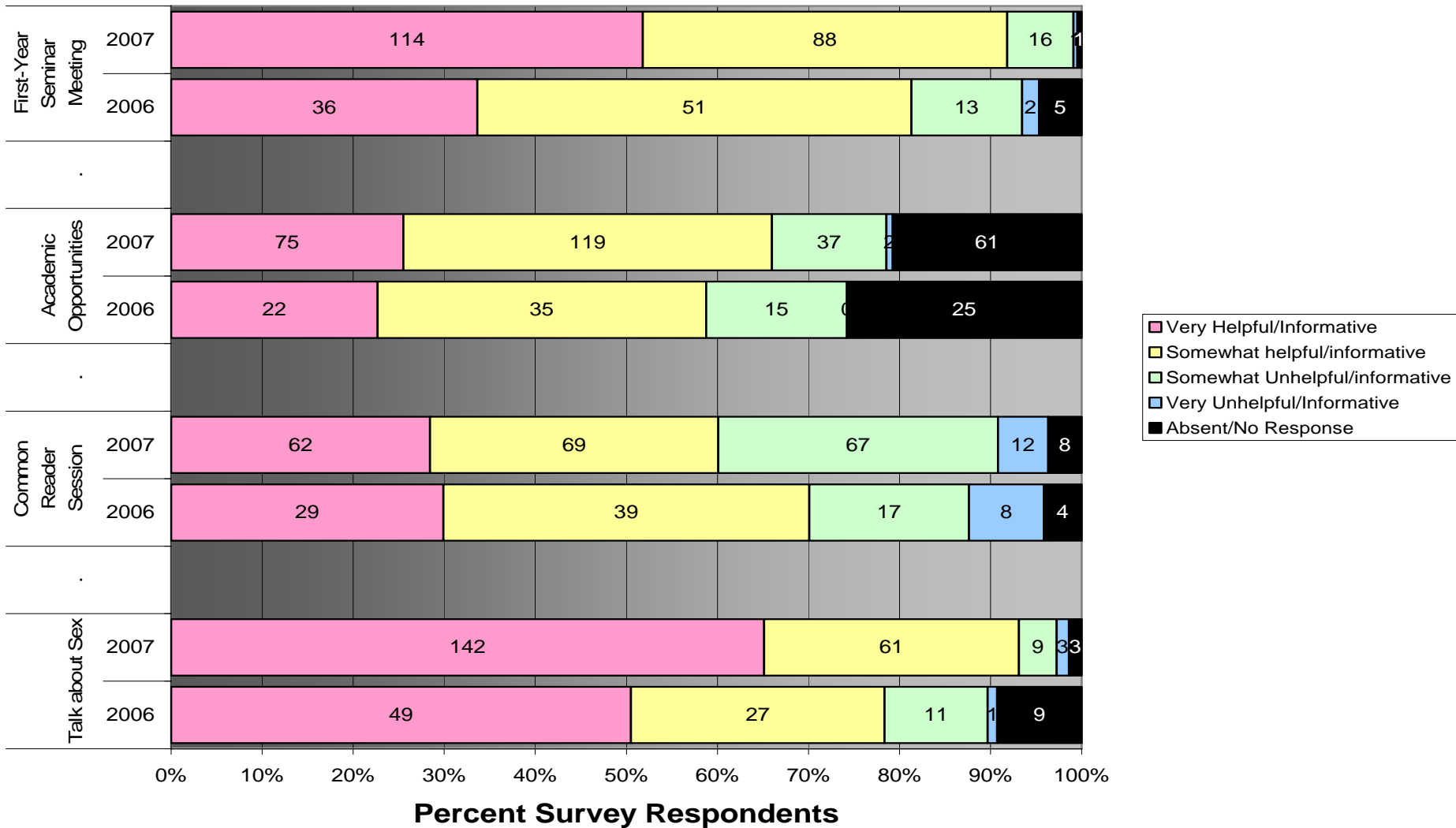
Report Format

- Required & optional events presented separately and ordered by day.
- Where events were held in 2006 and 2007, results are compared. Otherwise, only 2007 data are presented.
- Response categories (degree of positive response for events) are presented as percent of total number of respondents turning in paper survey (2007) or submitting completed form online (2006). Categories were:
 - For required events-
 - Very helpful/Informative
 - Somewhat Helpful/Informative
 - Somewhat Unhelpful/Uninformative
 - Very Unhelpful/Uninformative
 - Did not attend or blank
 - For optional events-
 - “2” for positive response
 - “1” for negative response
 - Did not attend or blank
 - In the 2006 survey, a 4-point scale was used – to compare with 2007 data, the two positive levels were combined as were the two negative levels.

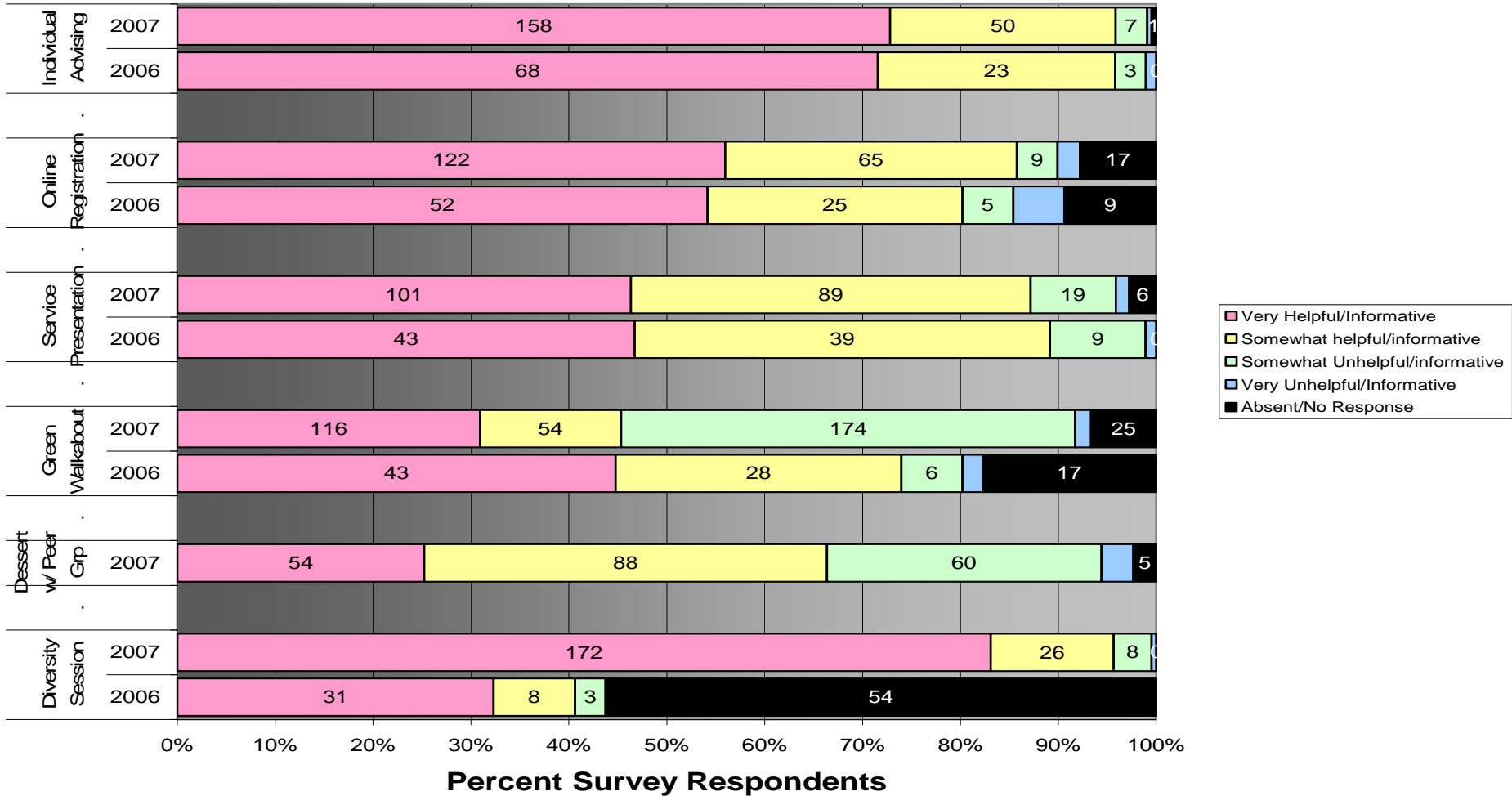
Required Events - Monday



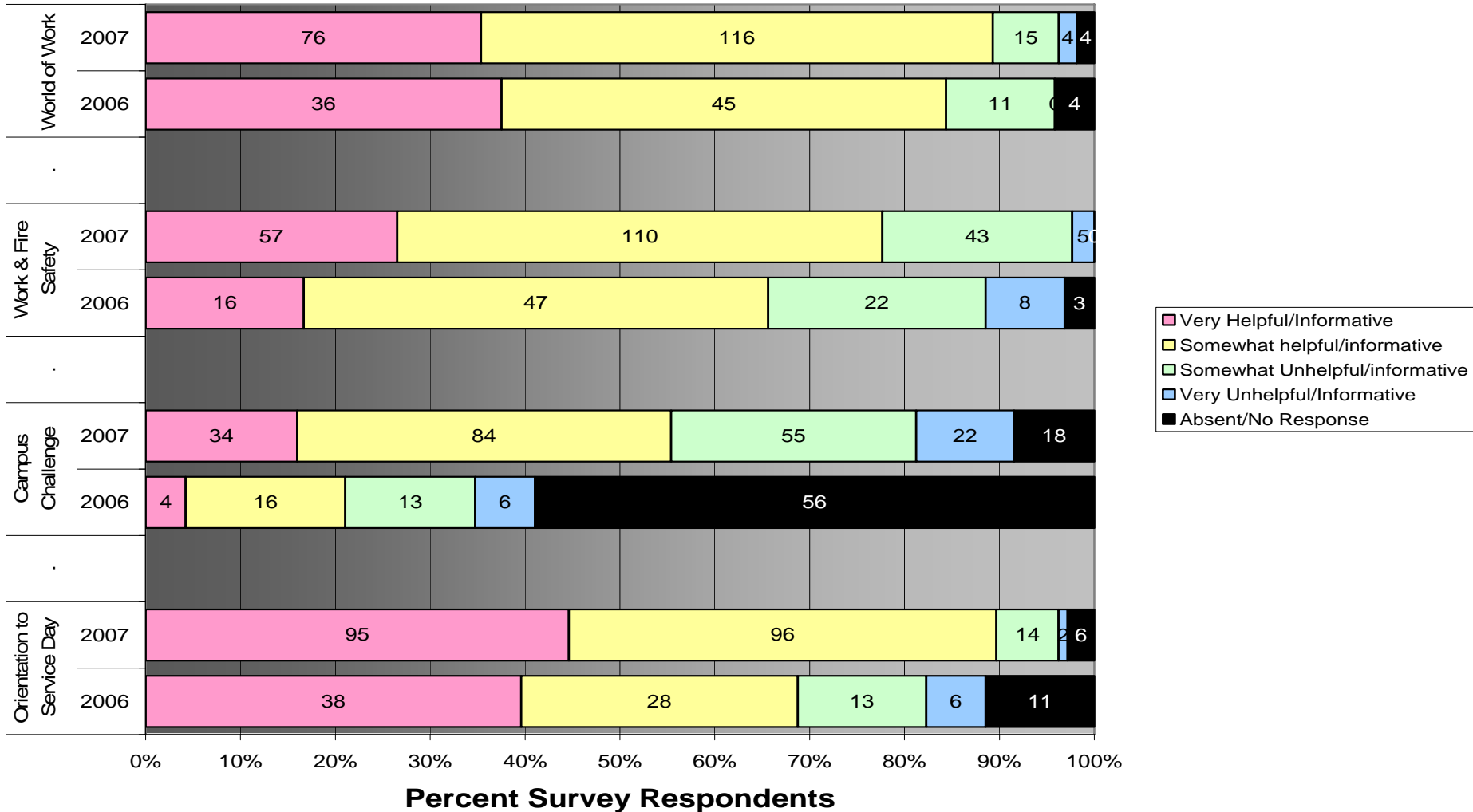
Required Events - Tuesday



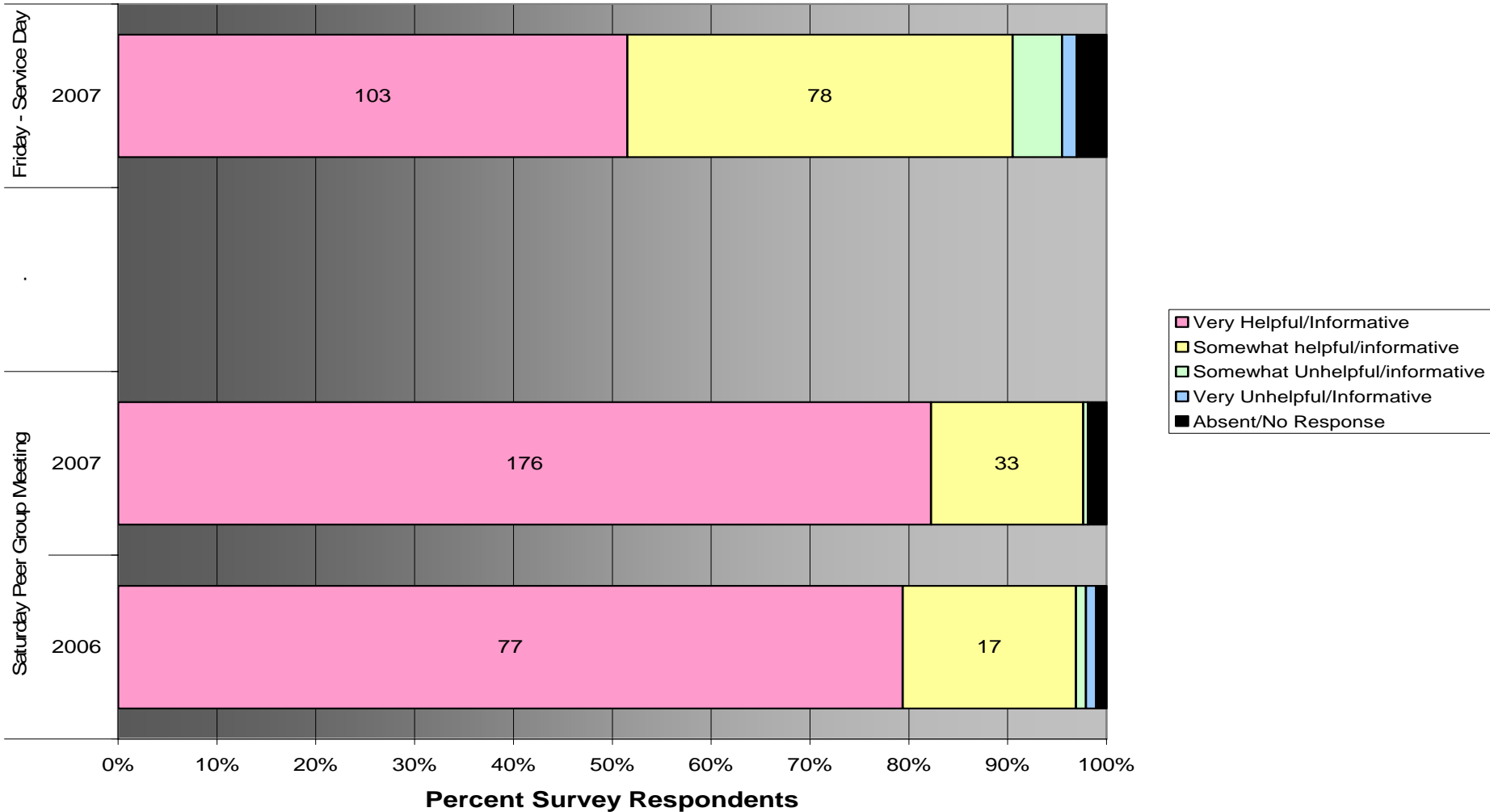
Required Events - Wednesday



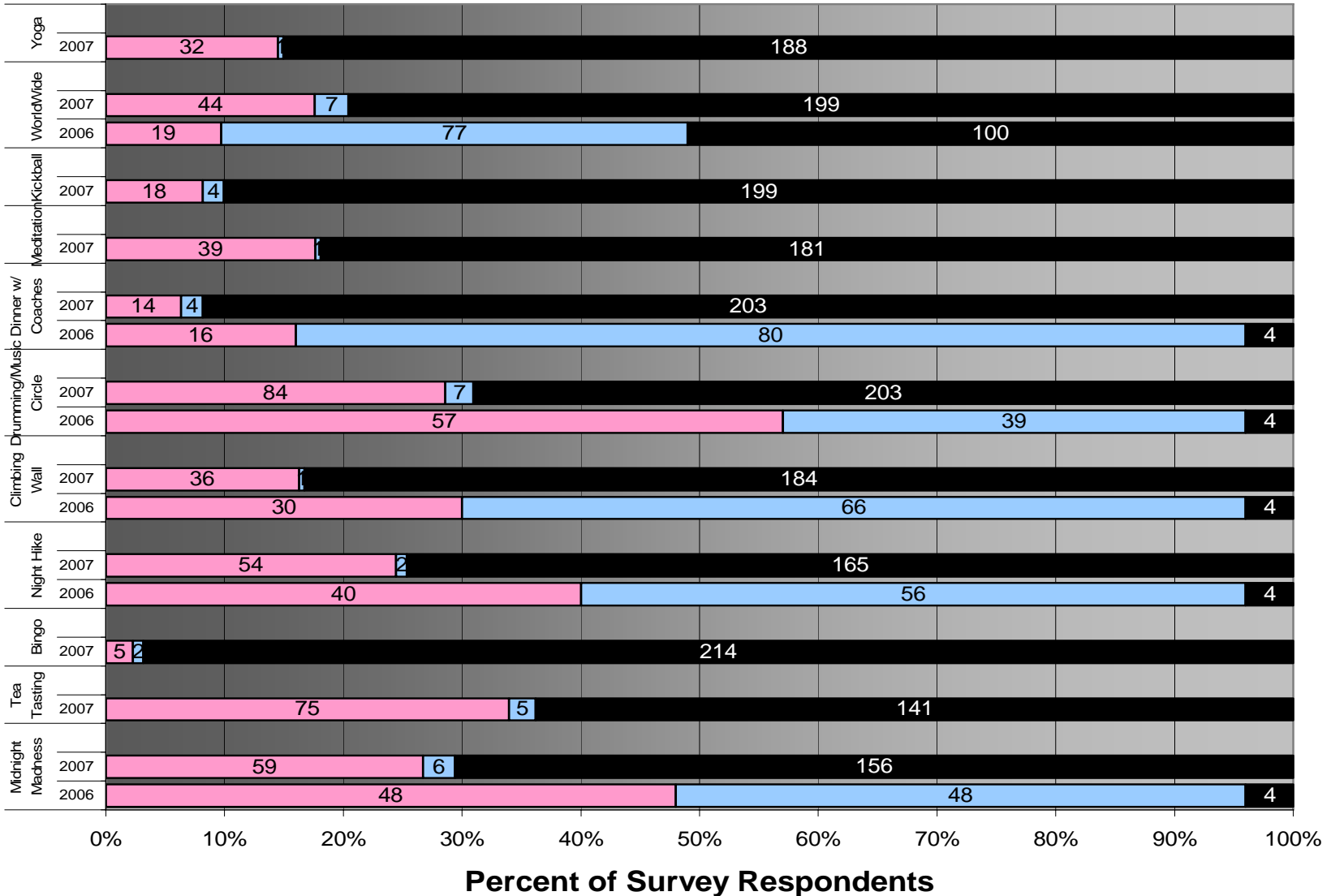
Required Events - Thursday
