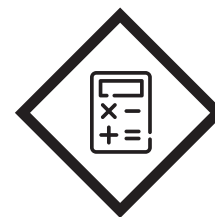


# Estimated Cost & Financial Aid.

## FINANCIAL AID & SCHOLARSHIPS:

- All applicants to the MA in Craft program will be considered for merit-based scholarships based on your completed application. There is not a separate application for these scholarships.
- If you wish to apply for an unsubsidized federal loan or Graduate PLUS loan, you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at: [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov), using your FSA I.D.
- You must have a FSA ID and password in order to file the FAFSA. Please safeguard your FSA ID credentials as they will be used to file a renewal FAFSA in subsequent years. The FSA ID also serves as your electronic signature for educational loans.
- The 2019–2020 FAFSA can be filed online any time at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov). Please make sure that you sign the FAFSA electronically using your FSA ID in order to avoid processing delays. If you DO NOT use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool and your FAFSA is selected for verification, you will be required to submit an official IRS 2017 Tax Return Transcript to complete the verification process.
- The FAFSA uses both your and your spouse's information (if applicable) to calculate your eligibility for federal student financial aid. For the 2019–2020 FAFSA, the Department of Education requires students to use 2017 federal income tax information.
- We recommend that you use the Data Retrieval Tool (DRT) in the FAFSA to upload your tax information directly from the IRS.
- Warren Wilson College's school code is **002979**.
- File the 2019–2020 FAFSA for the academic year that runs from July 2019 to June 2020.
